
"Reduce Suicide Attempts in Kilinochchi District"

Contextual analysis – Kilinochchi District

- Heavily affected by war, remains with war scars, even 10 years after end of the war
- Physical, social, economical and psychological issues exist
- Amidst suicide became a big threat. The rate increase over period. An average of over one attempt per day. Some instance..
 - **Four suicides just in one day on 01 Jan 2019**
 - From Jan to March 2019, nine suicide attempted cases were referred to UNHD counselors in the Kilinochchi hospital. 03 of them were school going kids
- Domestic violence, micro loans, insufficient or no family income, use of drugs and alcohol, loses of property or persons, extra marital affairs or sexual abuse, lack of awareness, and media exposure are common and interconnected reasons
- Treating only to mental health without counseling or resolving other underlying causes (livelihood)
- Shortage of technical personnel and other resources for hospitals and community to address psychosocial issues.

Objective & time frame

Objective: To reduce psychological stress especially the attempt of suicide among the identified communities, and improve their resilience and empowerment

Time Frame: Initially one year, March 2019 to March 2020



Strategy


Community level approach – preventive

- Counseling and family support
- Referral and networking
- Educating community

Hospital level approach – curative

- Counseling and follow up
- Referral and networking

Volunteers from the community will function as change agents. They will maintain contact with all services and facilitate access



Activities

- Counseling at hospitals and communities
- Community assessment and improve living standards
- Assist function of civil societies' and collaborate
- Set up volunteers or facilitators support mechanism
- Establish referral and networking service
- Public education and Awareness creation
- Training for the community leaders to handle personnel having suicide thoughts
- Training for the counselors attached to the Govt/NGO sectors





Expected results

- Decline in the numbers of suicidal attempts
- There will no longer be chances for repeated attempts and thoughts for suicide
- Number of ways and means will be increased to protect people having suicidal thoughts
- Improvement in understanding and support among the families due to continuous guidance and counseling
- Improved interaction and involvement between family and society due to awareness on suicides
- Students will be able to pay attention on their goals and ambitions, and understand socio-cultural values
- Improved living standards

Supervision and Monitoring

Supervision:

- MOMH/RDHS for hospital counsellors
- District and Divisional Counselors for the Community
- Peer support

Monitoring:

- Monthly psychosocial forum
- Internal monitoring using tools
